PISBDCN Hires Anastasia Dujmovic as RMI SBDC Center Director

Guam, USA — The Pacific Islands Small Business Development Center Network (PISBDCN), an organization committed to offering counseling and trainings in all areas of business development and management, welcomes Anastasia Dujmovic as the Republic of Marshall Islands Small Business Development Center Director (RMI SBDC). The University of Guam-Pacific Islands Small Business Development Center Network (PISBDCN) and the Guam Small Business Development Center (SBDC) is housed at the University of Guam School of Business and Public Administration. This network opened in 1995. From 1999 through 2002 five additional centers were opened, creating the first international SBDC Network. Service Centers are located in the Federated States of Micronesia (FSM) namely the Yap, Chuuk, Kosrae, and Pohnpei State, the Republic of Palau, and the Republic of Marshall Islands.
